## 2. Resolutions and Direction To Staff

## 2.1 2024 Budget Overview and Draft Capital Budget

Spokespersons: Clayton Harris, CAO, Administration;

Stephanie Phillips, Director of Finance

Stephanie Phillips, Director of Finance provided Council with an overview of the Capital budget from a prepared power point presentation. Ms. Phillips covered the following topics: Behind the 2024 Budget, Fiscal Policy Framework, Interest Rate & Inflation Forecast, Continuous Improvement, Benchmarking, Draft Capital Budget, Funding the Capital Budget, Reserves/Debentures, Grants/Current Yr Property Tax Funding, The Dedicated Capital Levy, 2024 Capital Items.

Staff responded to members of council requests for explanation on the reason for the costs of various items.

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Councillor Borneman suggested that Mayor McGarvey might bring forward to advocacy associations and organizations to call upon the province to provide incentives to move from gas powered equipment to electrification.

CAO Clayton Harris and Director of Public Works Mike Kearns responded to questions of Council regarding the benefits of proceeding with budgetary infrastructure items, taken in steps such as engineering design, and application for environmental permits for construction, while making application to the province to fund infrastructure in pursuit not only of the province's goal of more housing, but of cleaning up former oil brownfield properties. Mr. Harris identified that this was the subject of the Town delegation to the Minister of Infrastructure at the Rural Ontario Municipalities Association (ROMA) Conference last month. Mr. Harris also noted that MPP Graydon Smith was impressed by the Town map showing imminent development of a dozen properties including upon the former Shell and Imperial Oil lands just awaiting infrastructure and capacity upgrades.

Mr. Kearns noted that staff have been attending webinars on the recently announced provincial grant program - Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund (HEWSF), the requirements of which the Town readily meets.
